A linear route running along part of the River Sarela downstream. It is easy to access from the old town via the Galeras district. The walk enables you to see different uses of the river in the past, passing by old waterwheels, fountains, and washing places.

We recommend starting at **Ponte da Asén** (bridge), in **Parque das Galeras** (park), due to its proximity to the old town and because there are spaces for parking, eating establishments, a children's playground, etc.

From Ponte da Asén (bridge) we head downstream along an asphalted area, passing by the Fonte do Ouro fountain and following the track running parallel to the river, towards the football fields and basketball courts. After passing by the children's playground, we should turn right, following the path alongside the wall of the Finca do Espiño estate, which takes us as far as the Calzada do Carme de Abaixo road. There we have to cross the pedestrian crossing and turn left to pass by Capela do Carme de Abaixo (chapel). The path continues on the right, following the course of the River Sarela and passing by several restored buildings that used to be tanneries, as well as the Fonte and Lavadoiro de Bar de Abaixo (fountain and washing place).

We continue on and cross the small bridge facing **Fábrica** de Curtidos da Ponte do Rueiro de Figueiriñas (tannery), which is followed by a wooden walkway and another small bridge that takes us to the **Muíño and Fábrica de** Curtidos de Casas do Rego (waterwheel and tannery).

This entire area is full of old waterwheels and tanneries, with the trail passing by Muíño do Rueiro de Figueiriñas and several other waterwheels, the Muíños da Ribeira de San Lourenzo waterwheels, before reaching an asphalted street called A Ribeira de San Lourenzo. Here we should head right and go down to Pontella da Ribeira de San Lourenzo, which is a bridge located among houses. After crossing it, we should turn left to get back to the trail running parallel to the river, which is now on our left. We continue on passed the Muíños de Carcañeiras waterwheels and, after going over the small bridge called **Pontella de Carcañeiras**, we arrive at the Ponte Sarela bridge, where we come across Fábrica de Curtidos da Ribeira de San Lourenzo (tannery) and Fonte and Lavadoiro da Fábrica de Curtidos da Ribeira de San Lourenzo (fountain and washing place).

After returning to the Ponte da Asén bridge, we can extend our walk with Trail OI River Sarela Upstream, which takes us along the river course as far as the Fábrica de curtidos da Ponte Pedriña de Arriba tannery.
