THE ENCHANTMENT OF THE NATURE



LOCATION

O Pino Council, is located in the Province of A Coruña, at 18 kms of Santiago de Compostela. It is the first municipality from the capital city of Galicia to Lugo if you go to the national road N-547.



It has an extension of 133 km² which are distributed in 13 parishes: Arca, Budiño, Castrofeito, Cebreiro, Cerceda, Gonzar, Lardeiros, Medín, Pastor, Pereira, O Pino, San Mamede de Ferreiros and San Breixo de Ferreiros.

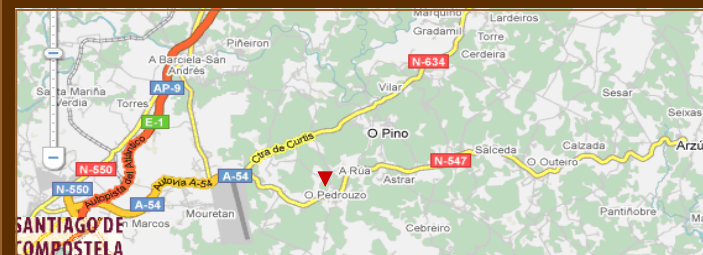
Arzúa. It is bordered on the North by Frades and Oroso, on the South by Touro and Boqueixón, on the East by Arzúa and the West by Santiago de Compostela.

The Tambre River, whose main affluent is the Mera, makes the division on the North of the municipality. There is also the affluent Noa, which rises in the parish of Pastor and flows into the Tambre River.

The climate can be placed within the damp oceanic weather. It is characterized by abundant showers as a consequence of the damp wind of the West.

HOW TO ARRIVE

In order to arrive to this council from Santiago de Compostela, you have to take the A-54 for about 9 kms. The A-54 flows in a roundabout, and you have to continue by the first exit to the N-547, for about 5 Kms which takes you to O Pedrouzo (Arca), that is the administrative centre of the O Pino Council. **(Coordenadas: 42°54'16N – 8°21'47O)**



WHAT YOU CAN SEE

NATURAL HERITAGE

If a colour has to define one council, the green would be the perfect colour of O Pino. Different types of green, mixed with an extensive range of warm colours.

The basins of the Tambre River, included in the protected areas of the Red Natura 2000, draw interesting places and create magnificent natural places. Moreover, they show along their course waterwheels, recreational areas or river beaches.



As an example of these natural elements there are the recreacional area of Pontedapedra and the river beach of A Tarroeira.



Another spots that you must visit in O Pino Council are the “Carballeira da Feira do Vinte” in Cebreiro, the beautiful recreational area of A Magdalena in Castrofeito and the waterfall of Noa River.



CULTURAL AND HISTORICAL HERITAGE

RELIGIOUS ARCHITECTURE

Here it is a required reference the very well know “Cathedral of the Mountain”, the church of San Julián de Lardeiros, which is remarkable for its dimensions and beauty. In Gonzar there is the amazing church of Gonzar. It is said that near to the high altar of this church there is the tomb of Josefa de la Torre, a mysterious woman who wasn't eat or drinking for several decades, as the legend tells, and as a consequence of this, she started to be known as a Saint.

In O Pino there are four chapels: the chapel of Santa Irene in Arca, the chapels of Santiso and A Magdalena in Castrofeito and the chapel of San Andrés in Gonzar.



CIVIL ARCHITECTURE

The past of the great familias that resided in O Pino can be appreciated in the stately big houses that you can find in the municipality. Sample of it, are the different Pazos: Pazo del Marqués de Montesacro or Pazo de Bermás, Pazo de Porto Outeiro in Medín, or Pazo do Picón en Arca. **All these “pazos” are private properties and not visitables.**



ETNOGRAPHIC ELEMENTS



O Pino is a rich council in heritage and tradition, and in this town are “cruceiros” of all the periods and styles for the whole municipality. One of the most singular is the one of



Lardeiros, which dates of 1700 and its combines two artistic trends: the neoclassic and the baroque. In this municipality there are several “hórreos”, a lot of mills, serveral fountains and many typical Galician washing places.

ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES

It is important to emphasize the army settlement of San Lorenzo de Pastor, a place where it was found an oval enclosure of 110 metres in lenght and it was also found pottery remains without decoration and two gold celtic necklaces of 22 carats and 350 grams. All these can be examined in the Archeological Museum of the San Antón Castle (A Coruña). Appar to from two forts in Oza (Ferreiros) and Tarroeira (O Pino), there are also a Romanesque bridge of Ponte Puñide on the Mera River. In this point it was found one bronze Modium which is from the years 360/370 and is showed in the National Archaeological Museum.



WHAT TO DO

NATURAL ROUTES

PANORAMIC ROUTE OF PICÓN. It is a circular tour from the parish of Arca, with a tracing of 9 kms, that rises up to the Mountain of the Picón to a beautiful viewing-point, and comes back to the historical place of A Rúa and Astrar's Mills, crossing beautiful natural places.



BOTANICAL ROUTE OF MERA. This Fluvial Route, with a linear tour of 4 kms, passes for the Mera River, from the fluvial beach of A Tarroeira, to the Church of Gonzar, crossing for the Mill of Pena and the Roman Bridge of Ponte Puñide. In her, there are signs of the natural species of the landscape of the river.



CULTURAL ITINERARY OF THE MOUNTAIN. This itinerary of 18 kms, is an alternative to realize in vehicle with the help of the virtual guides of O Pino, and passes to the parishes of Lardeiros, Medín and Pastor, putting in value the patrimonial wealth and the beautiful places that characterize these three parishes.

CAMINO DE SANTIAGO (THE FRENCH WAY)

O Pino is the municipality which has more kilometres of the French Way, with the finish in the Apostol Santiago City. The route winds between five parish of the municipality: San Verísimo de Ferreiros, San Miguel de Cerceda, Arca, San Miguel de Pereira and Castrofeito.



FESTIVALS

The principal event is the Gallo Piñeiro Festival and Muestra Caballar (Horse Exhibition), the 1º Sunday of August (*Tourist Interesting Festival of Galicia since 2010*). The Romería of San Pedro in Santa Irene the 29 of June and A Magdalena the 22 of July in Castrofeito, have also a great tradition.
